### **Optional tour – 25 June 2014**

A 3.5-hour coach trip to The Zamoyski Museum in Kozłówka will be organized on 25 June, 2014.

The museum consists of the Palace erected around 1742, the Chapel, designed after the royal chapel of the Versailles – with its stuccoworks, the colonnade, the altar and the organ front copied from the model, the Coach-house and the Park.

The Kozłówka Palace was redeveloped in the years 1897–1914. It has preserved its original Second-Empire-style décor from the late 19th and early years of the 20th century. The Palace boasts a wonderful gallery of paintings and sculptures, including family portraits, portraits of rulers and historic personages, French and Polish 2nd Empire-style pieces of furniture, a collection of exquisite ceramics and glass, as well as French, English, Russian, Polish and Austrian silver-plated vessels, and many more.

Historic horse-drawn carts from the 19th and early 20th century are displayed in the Coach-house, along with various harnesses, saddles and riding accessories of historical interest, a number of interesting travel-related objects and sports and tourism oddities.
